

The Joint Radio Committee of the  
Nationalised Power Industries

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Main Committee

To examine and co-ordinate the requirements of the Nationalised Power Industries for radio operation for all purposes.

To negotiate with the Post Office on behalf of the Nationalised Power Industries all general matters associated with radio operation and such specific matters which may be deemed necessary.

To foster new developments in the field of radio operation relevant to the Industries' needs, and the interchange of technical and operational information between the Industries.

2. Mobile Radio Technical Sub-Committee

The Mobile Radio Technical Sub-Committee will be responsible for advising the Joint Radio Committee on technical and administrative aspects of mobile radio networks.

When a point-to-point radio link is an integral part of a mobile radio system and does not form the spur of a more complex communication network, the Sub-Committee will consider it to be within its field of responsibility.

Where a mobile base station is remotely controlled over a speech channel in a microwave radio point-to-point system, the Secretary will act as a liaison between the Mobile Radio and the Radio Networks Technical Sub-Committees.

3. Radio Networks Technical Sub-Committee

The Radio Networks Technical Sub-Committee will be responsible for advising the Joint Radio Committee on technical and administrative aspects of radio networks, other than those within the terms of reference of the Mobile Radio Technical Sub-Committee.

Where a radio network embraces mobile radio base stations, the Secretary will act as a liaison between the Radio Networks and the Mobile Radio Technical Sub-Committees.
