POINT-TO-POINT LINKS IN THE 1444-1535 MHz BAND -
CHANNEL FOR TEST PURPOSES

The following frequencies may be used for path proving, standby and emergency use:-

Sub-band F (Single channel & 1+1 systems) 1478.950/1498.450 MHz
Sub-bands E & B (6-8 & 12-24 channel systems) 1467.125/1529.625 MHz

These frequencies may be used anywhere in the UK for short durations, provided that equipment conforms to the current Home Office performance specifications MPT 1500 B, MPT 1500 E, MPT 1500 F, relevant to the channel capacity required.

Equipment should be licensed for use on the above channel, as and where a requirement for the service arises, details being submitted through the JRC on Form BR8. If the use of the channel is to be of very short duration, say two or three days, or at very short notice in an emergency, it will suffice to notify the Home Office by letter, telephone, or telex, providing full details.

It may be of assistance to Boards and Regions to know where this channel is in operation at any given time. To enable the JRC to provide this service, users are asked to send copies of all correspondence with the Home Office regarding the use of the channel to the JRC at the following address:
